There has been a lot of hard work put in by employees and members and it is starting to show. If you have not played in a while you need to get on the course and enjoy it! The fairways were sprayed end of July beginning of August for weed control and fertilized shortly after. The Bermuda is really starting to take off and the fairways have never looked better. There will be a second application of herbicide and fertilizer coming soon to continue to remove the weeds and fill in the bare spots. This will help ensure better fairways next year during the golf season. The putting green and number 8 green



have made a remarkable come back from the damage they received back in April. The ground crew has been working hard to get them back and they are almost there. As the weather starts to cool off, we should see more improvement with hopes of full recovery before winter. Deep tine aerification was just completed for the second time this year and a core aerification scheduled end of September. The greens will be a little bumpy for a few weeks, but with the early aerification, they are expected to heal before winter, so the greens are playable throughout the winter and ready for next spring. To help keep the greens in great shape, please remember to fix the ball marks on the greens. Even if you did not make one, try to fix a couple on each green. If we all do this, we can fix them all!

The pool season has been a success. Thank you to all the pool members and swim team members for another successful season and we look forward to seeing you again next year. We will begin closing the pool and prepping for the 2024 season!
