- July 23rd is the Gator end of season swim team party. The pool will close early at 4 pm that day.

A few reminders to keep our pool facilities safe and enjoyable for all our members:

- Please make sure your trash makes it into a trash can.
- The baby pool is for children 5 and under, please do not allow your older children to play in the baby pool.
- Remember that children using flotation devices must be supervised by a parent or guardian within arm's reach.
- Vomiting and bathroom accidents in the pool require closing the pool for cleanup and chemical treatment. Individuals who vomit or have a bathroom accident in the pool must stay out of the pool for at least 24 hours. Children who are not toilet trained must wear swim diapers or closely fitting rubber/plastic pants.
- It's great to see adults and children alike enjoying our pickleball and tennis courts when they are not in use. However, please do not allow your children to play on the pickleball/tennis courts when they are in use and at no time should they hang on, climb on, or otherwise abuse the nets. They are very fragile.
